# MARSDEN PARK SUMMER SIXES COMP FAQS

# How do I sign up?

Firstly, get your mates together to form a team.

Nominate a Team Manager to complete and lodge a Team Nomination Form including a list of your player's full names. You will also need a team name and decide your team colours/uniform.

MPGFC SS will then contact your Team Manager to confirm acceptance of the team. Once the Team is accepted, the Team Manager then registers as a Manager in Dribl. A unique Team Code will be generated and sent to the Manager. The Manager then provides the Team Code to the team players. Players may commence registering as a Player via DRIBL and will need the Team Code to complete the registration process.

## How many players do I need to form a team?

You will need a minimum of 6 and maximum of 10 players.

U7 will need a minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 7.

# What age group do I register for?

You need to register for the age group your eldest player is turning this year ie, turning 9 this calendar year can only play in U9, or can play up an age group in U10 or U11. A player turning 9 this year cannot play in U8 or below.

## What happens after my team is registered?

Your Team Manager will receive a confirmation email of the team's registration to the competition.

The Manager should follow up with the team to ensure all Players have completed their registration.

Once all your Players have completed their registration and payment, your team is ready for kick off. You just need to finalise your team uniform ready for first game.

## Who arranges our uniform / jerseys?

Your team needs to arrange your own uniform. All team players must wear the same uniform/jersey with their own unique number on the back when on the field.

## How much is Registration?

Registration fees are \$100 for all junior members up to U15 and \$120 U16 and over / adults.

# How do I pay for Summer Football?

The registration process will accept online only payments via Visa or Mastercard.

#### Are there any other fees to pay?

No, registration fee will cover all costs to play, however, you will need to arrange a team uniform at your own costs.

#### How many Players are on the field?

Teams will play 6 v 6 on the field including a goal keeper.

U7's will only play 4 v 4 on the field with no goal keeper.

#### How many teams are in the competition?

We are aiming to accept 8 teams in each of the age group from U8 and above and 6 teams in U7, depending on demand. Some age groups may be combined. First in, best dressed!

## What night and time do we play?

Games will be played on either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday with game times from 7.30pm

Game schedule will be released once final registrations are accepted.

You will play one game per week on a fixed day and time at Elara Oval.

There is no training required.

## I cannot play on the set night or time. Can this be changed?

Unfortunately, the game schedules will be set and cannot be changed. If the schedule does not suit your team, you will have an opportunity to withdraw from the competition prior to the competition commencing.

## Do we have to play every week?

Yes! The competition requires your team to turn up and play each week. The team you are playing against are expecting you.

Please do not submit and register a team if your team is not committed to playing for the duration of the season.

#### When does the season commence and end?

Season kick off will be the week of 16 September, 2024 and last round will be the week of 28 November, 2024.

Finals will be played over 2 weeks, commencing the week of 2 December 2024 and 9 December 2024.

Every age group from U8 will contest finals. There are no finals for U7.

# How many divisions are there?

Divisions may be offered in senior age groups, depending on demand for team placement in the competition.

# What if there are not enough teams to create a competition?

We will endeavour to combine competitions if there are not enough teams. If combining age groups is not an option, we may cancel age groups and offer full refunds.

# What if it's raining or extreme heat?

Games may be played in the rain. Weather will be monitored and games will be called off if fields are deemed unsafe to play. Extreme heat may also cause games to be called off. In such events, field/game status will be communicated via the official Marsden Park Galaxy FC Facebook page.

# I don't have a team to play in, can I register?

Unfortunately, we do not place individuals into teams. However, if you do not have a team, you can complete and submit an Individual Player Form, providing your contact details and age group to be placed in our register. If any teams are looking for an extra player, we can provide them with your details to contact you direct.

# Are there Rules & Regulations and where can I find them?

Yes, there will be competition Rules & Regulations and it will be deemed all Managers and Players agree to them by registering to play.
